

STAAR EOC Summer Tutorials: Frequently Asked Questions

1. My child did not pass the STAAR EOC exam. Are they REQUIRED to attend the summer tutorials at Timberview High School?

Answer: No. Attendance at Summer Tutorials is strictly voluntary. However, we do encourage all students needing to retest to attend the tutorials in preparation for the STAAR EOC retest.

2. Can my student still retest even if they do not attend the tutorials?

Answer: Yes. Retest will be given the week of June 19-22nd at each student's *home campus*. Students should check with their home campus for times and locations for each test.

3. Can my student attend the tutorials even if they passed all of their EOC exams and do not need to retest?

Answer: No. The tutorials are specifically for students who need to retest in order to meet the requirements for graduation. Students seeking general subject area tutorials should not attend the STAAR EOC tutorials.

4. Can my student attend only one of the two sessions each day instead of attending both session 1 and session 2?

Answer: Yes. However, it is preferred that a student wishing to attend only one session each day be in attendance for Session 1 (8:00AM) during the daily check-in time and then leave at 9:25 each day.

5. My student needs to retest in two or more subject areas. How will the tutorials work for them so that they can get help in each subject area?

Answer: Students will be allowed to rotate through up to two sessions each day. For example, a student needing English and Algebra I tutorials will be able to attend 85 minutes of tutoring in each subject area each day. If a student needs to attend 3 subject areas, then we will have them rotate through the tutorials over the 4 days.
