- ✓ I will check my grades in Skyward weekly and notify my teacher of any concerns immediately.

I will...**

- ✓ Let the teacher know if my child has any problems with learning.
- ✓ Use resources the school sends home to help my child.
- ✓ Help my child see how education is relevant in the pursuit of his/her interests and goals.
- ✓ Assure that my child gets 8 hours of rest a night.
- ✓ Assure my child attends school regularly.
- ✓ Provide an area for my child to complete homework without distractions.
- ✓ Support my child and the school by attending Open House and other campus events.
- ✓ I will use the Skyward system to stay up to date with my child's grades, attendance and discipline.
